Treasurer	B. Macklin presented the budget for 2020 and noted that there is a	
	\$75.00 increase in the service fee. Bob explained some expenses are	
	increasing, some capital improvements are being recommended and	
	we want to build our rainy day fund to a more comfortable level to be	
	determined by the Board of Directors.	
	Motion made and duly seconded to increase Annual Service Fee by	
	\$75.00.	
	P. Van Steeden explained the ideas for improving security at the	
	beaches.	
	1. At Little Beach a new gate system will replace the current gate on	
	Stacey Lane. A new gate will be combined with the existing gate at	
	the boat launch entry. Galvanized steel posts will be used to attach	
	the gates. The approximate cost will be \$1500.00. This cost comes	
	from this year's budget.	
	2. A fence will be installed that encloses Little Beach. The	
	approximate cost will be \$5000.00.	
	3. A new system using a key will replace the combination locks. The	
	key will not be able to be duplicated. A new gate door will be	
	installed that is self-closing and has a push bar inside. The	
	approximate cost will be \$5000.00.	
	Discussion followed which included the following ideas and concerns:	
	One key per family is not enough.	
	Could an assessment fee cover these improvements rather than an	
	Annual Service Fee increase?	
	Bad behavior at beaches is from members or renters and their guests	
	not from outsiders	
	Landlords need to be notified of renters' bad behavior	
	These improvements are moving the Association forward.	
	Reduce trash pickup to every other week. Discussion ended.
